


Mondays with the Mayor

Ulysses Park Improvement Work

Long-awaited park improvements are coming to Ulysses Park! Contractors will be onsite beginning the week of Nov. 25 . Park closures will go into effect at that time.

Here's what you should know:

- The skate park and adjacent parking lot will remain open unless otherwise noted.
- Most other areas of the park will be closed through the completion of the project in Fall 2025.
- The new dog park is planned to reopen first as work is completed.

C470 Temporary Trail Closure

The Golden Overlook Subdivision Development, located off W 4th Ave, is under construction. City staff has worked closely with the developer to ensure minimal impacts to the surrounding communities, but access to the C470 Trail has been temporarily closed due to utility construction. The trail closure is being extended through the end of December due to unforeseen construction delays. Trail access is scheduled to reopen in January. While we know this is very inconvenient for trail users, the closure is necessary to ensure everyone's safety.



- Access to parking & Golden Heights Park still open from W 2nd Place.


East Street & Ford Street corridors from 13th Street to 23rd Street
