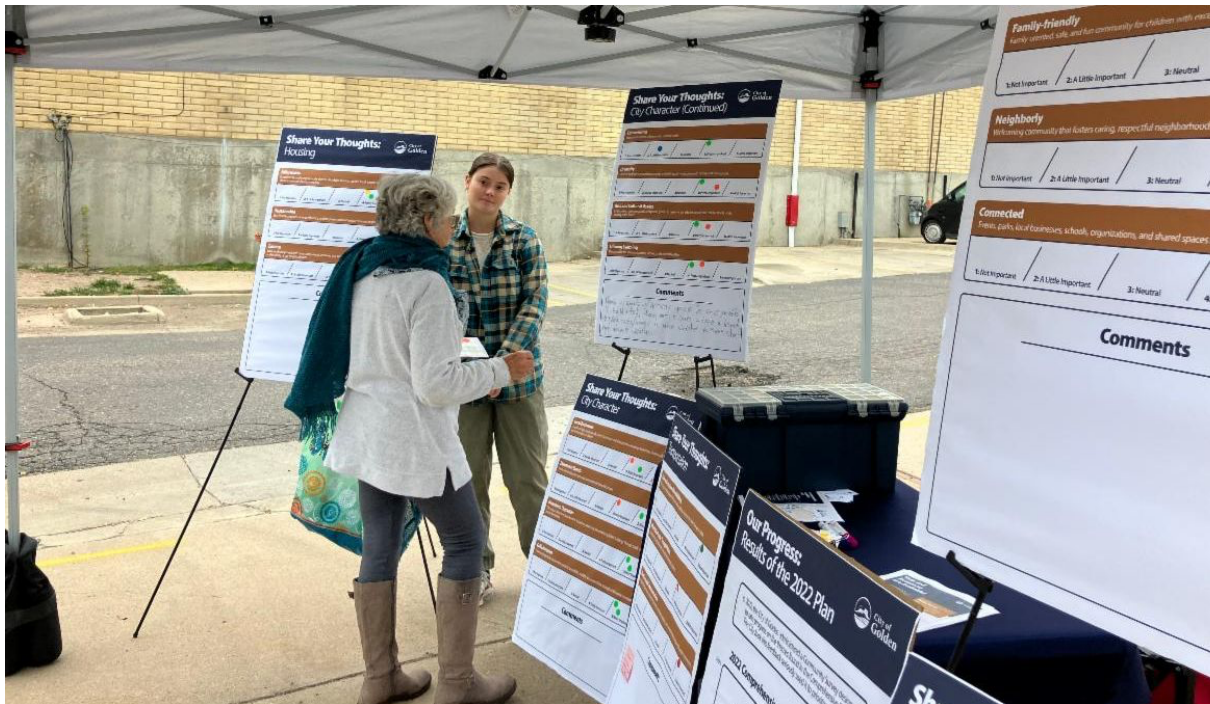


Mondays with the Mayor

It serves as both the process and the documentation for creating a long-term vision for future land uses and the built environment. It lays the foundation for zoning codes, which are the legal means for implementing the vision of the future contained in the Plan.

City Parking Permits Renewed Through 2025

The City and our parking contractor are automatically renewing Golden Resident and Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) permits through 2025. No additional action is required by permit holders. Additional vehicles or changes to existing license plates can be added online at ParkGoldenCO.com.

If you have questions about your permit, please contact Interstate directly at parkgoldenco@interstateparking.com or (720) 885-3035. A software glitch resulted in some residents receiving a notice to renew their permits. This notice can be ignored as the permits have been renewed for 2025.

Please note Downtown Employee permits are managed directly by the business and are valid until deactivated.



Lena Gulch Project Phase 1

Work on phase I (US HW40/West Colfax Ave. and the Heritage Rd. Interchange) of the Lena Gulch Channel Improvement Project began Monday, Dec. 9. The first phase of work will be the relocation of water and sanitary mains and will require the closure of the acceleration lane from Heritage Rd. onto West Colfax Ave. This lane will be closed for the duration of the project with full closure of Heritage Rd. for the construction of a box culvert likely beginning in January 2025.



Ulysses Park Redevelopment Project

The Ulysses Skatepark will be closed until approx. Feb. 10 due to construction in the north parking lot and surrounding areas. This closure ensures public and contractor safety while allowing work on the new dog park to progress efficiently.


