- Golden's in Golden is next Saturday, Feb.8.



This Friday, Jan. 31, is the last day you can drop off your tree at our new collection site at 230 Depot St., near the intersection of 10th and Vasquez. The site is open daily from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

To participate, please ensure your tree meets the following guidelines:

- Remove all ornaments, hardware, strings of lights, and tinsel.
- Only live Christmas trees will be accepted.
- Wreaths, tree branches, trash bags, or other wood materials will not be accepted.

The collected trees will be turned into mulch, which will be available for free pickup later at the public site on 11th St., just west of the Clear Creek History Park.



• Full closure of Heritage Road and Colfax (US Highway 40) south of the Apex parking lot will continue through March.


Colorado School of Mines 18th St Projects
