Right of Way Impacts

Unless otherwise noted, all impacts will be in effect on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (holidays excluded). Closures will be specifically noted.

Ford St. - Clayworks project

- Through March 14
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and sidewalk impacts with pedestrian/bicycle detours in place

Downtown Holiday Decor Removal

- Feb. 17 through 28
- Washington Ave. on Feb. 20
- Expect temporary parking and sidewalk impacts

East St. & Ford St. corridors from 13th St. to 23rd St. – Xcel Energy gas main/service replacements

- Through Feb. 28
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and parking/sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place

- Full closure of Heritage Road and Colfax (US Highway 40) south of the Apex parking lot will continue through March.

Welcome to the Public Road Closures App


