As the storm rages outside, tensions flare, secrets unravel, and long-buried conflicts resurface, creating a whirlwind of laughter, heartbreak, and unexpected connection. “*National Bohemians* is a comedy with bite and deeply personal roots, about the ties that bind (and sometimes strangle) us,” said Sorge. “I’m thrilled to collaborate with Miners Alley to bring this story to life with an incredible cast and creative team.”

At its core, the play follows estranged brothers Thom and Oscar, who return home to face a storm far bigger than the one outside. Their older brother, John, has taken their mother from her care facility, claiming he’s ending her suffering. As the chaos intensifies, the brothers must confront long-buried truths—leading to a shocking revelation.
