# RADON TEST

### DETECT THE INVISIBLE GAS



#### Free Radon Test Kit

As part of the City of Golden's Healthy Housing initiative, the City is partnering with Jefferson County Public Health to distribute 75 free radon test kits to Golden residents. Radon is a naturally-occurring invisible, odorless gas that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil, rock, and water. About 50% of homes in Colorado have high radon levels.

In Colorado, living in a home with average levels of radon is like having 200 chest x-rays every year. Testing for radon is easy and fixing the problem is relatively inexpensive.


