# Free Radon Test Kits Available

As part of the City of Golden's Healthy Housing initiative, the City is partnering with Jefferson County Public Health to distribute 100 free radon test kits to Golden residents and this is the last week for pick-up! Radon is a naturally occurring invisible, odorless gas that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil, rock, and water. About 50% of homes in Colorado have high radon levels.

# **Ore Cart Reroute**

Due to ongoing construction on Arapahoe Street, the 13th & Miners Alley stop on the Ore Cart Gold Route will be temporarily relocated to Washington Avenue & 14th Street through the end of May.

During this time, the Ore Cart will follow a temporary detour, traveling down 14th Street instead of 13th before rejoining its regular route.



# **Golden Community Center Sauna**

We're working through the final steps to get the sauna back up and running. An access panel install is next, which will require a temporary closure of the men's shower.

After that, cabling work will take place over two nights, followed by a final heater test. If all goes well, the sauna could reopen as early as April 21, but timing may shift depending on contractor availability and equipment condition.



• Full closure of Heritage Road at Colfax (US Highway 40) south of the Apex parking lot will continue through April.


