The Mayor is looking into an alternative schedule for June for Mondays with the Mayor, but planning to return to the regular schedule in July! Stay tuned for details.



Creek Update

With summer just around the corner, the City has begun meeting routinely on Creek Management and plans to provide a weekly update.

You and your loved ones may be eager to enjoy Clear Creek. However, recent rainfall and mountain snowmelt have led to rising water levels. Beginning Monday, June 2, the City of Golden posted Yellow Flags—indicating moderate to high flows. Under this warning, the creek is considered unsafe for children under 18, and all users should use extra caution. With the water running higher and quicker, the City anticipates moving to red in the near future.

To stay safe:

1. Check flag status before entering the creek. Flags are posted at major bridge crossings and updated on the [Visit Golden website](#), in the Weekly Digest, and on City social media.
2. Wear personal protective equipment like life jackets, typically referred to as PFDs (personal floatation device).
3. Beware of cold water temperatures, which can cause hypothermia even on hot days. Know the symptoms and get out of the water if they occur.
4. Always approach the creek with a buddy, even on the banks, and wear a PFD. The water can be quicker than you think.

City emergency responders are training in the Creek on swift water rescue through mid-June. Watch for ongoing training activity and continued updates.

Welcome to the Public Road Closures App


