Community Marketing Board Applications are Open

This newly created board will play a vital role in guiding marketing strategies and investments that promote Golden's businesses, support economic vitality, and reflect the unique character of our community.

The board was established through Ordinance 2267 and replaces the former Community Marketing Stakeholder Committee. Its purpose is to oversee the Community Marketing Fund and ensure marketing efforts benefit businesses across all areas of the City — from Downtown to North Golden, Southeast to South — while supporting sectors such as retail, food and beverage, lodging, and culture.

Creek Update

On June 9, Clear Creek's flag status changed to red due to high, fast-moving water and safety risks. This means that inner tubes, single-chamber rafts, belly boats, swimming, and body surfing are not allowed—those using kayaks, canoes, guided multi-chambered rafts, stand-up paddle boards, and river boards should practice extreme caution and ensure they have proper safety gear. This is a safety measure to protect our community as water levels rise with snowmelt.

Violators may be fined. Restrictions will remain in place until conditions improve.

As temperatures rise, so does traffic along the creek. The corridor through Golden has many beautiful spots to sit by the creek, as well as areas that are fenced off for natural resource protection. When looking for a place to sit or enter the creek, keep an eye out for signage and fencing indicating these spots, helping us all maintain the natural beauty of the Clear Creek Corridor.

Right of Way Impacts

Unless otherwise noted, all impacts will be in effect on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (holidays excluded). Closures will be specifically noted.

JeffCo Government Area (Jefferson County Parkway from W. 6th Avenue to Weimer Street)

- Through June 26, 2025
- Expect construction-related traffic delays

Lena Gulch Project

- Heritage Road is now open. Work continues with minimum impact of to traffic. Expect some construction related traffic delays.


City-wide

- Xcel Energy overhead power pole replacements/maintenance – wildfire mitigation
- Through August 29, 2025
- Expect construction related traffic delays and parking/sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place


Welcome to the Public Road Closures App


