


Summer Informer Available Online

We are making some improvements to our downtown parking garages, including new paint to help identify levels and upgraded lights. We will have rolling closures of specific spots or levels to make these updates, but we will keep the garage open and operational during the entire upgrade!

Improvements will begin with the southern structure.



Independence Day In Golden

In observance of Independence Day, all city administrative offices and the Golden Community Center will be closed on July 4th. Essential services, such as police and fire, will operate as normal.

Parking and Traffic

Planning ahead will make your Fourth of July in Golden smooth and stress-free. There are several free and paid parking options, as well as bike racks and shuttle services to help visitors get to and from Lions Park with ease.

FREE parking options include:

- Shuttle service from the Jefferson County Human Services building (900 Jefferson County Parkway) and the Jeffco RTD W Line Station
- Secure on-site bike racks (bring your lock!)
- Limited parking at the Clear Creek Lot (10th & Archer) and Colorado School of Mines Lot K (11th & Maple)

Paid parking options nearby include:

Jackson Street North and South Public Garages.

- Street parking throughout downtown Golden and along the 10th Street corridor
- The East Garage off Washington and 18th Streets.

Creek Update

Clear Creek has shifted to yellow flag status, meaning that the creek is open to all uses but is still considered unsafe for children under 18. So far this summer, there have been more than a dozen water rescues, including eight in the past week alone. Conditions remain swift and unpredictable, and extra caution is strongly advised when recreating. Personal flotation devices (PFDS) are strongly encouraged.

No matter what watercraft you're using on the creek, be prepared to exit the creek at Vanover Park—this is the last safe take-out point before the Coors Hydraulic Dam. Passing the dam can result in serious injury.

Stay alert, know your limits, and plan your route carefully to stay safe on the water.

Please respect all posted warnings and closures. Your safety—and the safety of our first responders—depends on it.

Unless otherwise noted, all impacts will be in effect on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (holidays excluded). Closures will be specifically noted.


City-wide
