## **Demolition at the Police and Municipal Building**

Demolition at 311 10th Street officially kicked off September 2, marking an exciting milestone in the Police and Municipal Building project. This visible progress signals the start of site activity, with fencing scheduled to go up later this week to prepare the area for construction. Early next week, crews will begin drilling geothermal wells, an important step in building an energy-efficient facility that will serve the community for decades to come.

## **Affordable Housing Applications Open through October 1**

The City of Golden is opening applications to support development and preservation of affordable housing funding to help keep our community a place where everyone can call home. Two options are available: \$179,478 in one-time City funding for 2025, and an anticipated \$3M through the Golden Housing Trust Fund in early 2026.

Applications are open September 1 through October 1, with decisions by December 31. Projects must serve households within income limits and include permanent affordability measures, like deed restrictions or land trusts. 

## Welcome to the Public Road Closures App


