Washington Avenue – Highway 58 to 9th Street

- Clayworks project concrete and asphalt work

West 10th Ave – Johnson Road to Ulysses Street

- City of Golden contractor installing new school flasher

- Expect construction-related traffic delays and sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place

Ulysses Street – 9th Avenue to 12th Avenue

- City of Golden contractor installing new curb/gutter and sidewalk


Welcome to the Public Road Closures App


