## **Police and Municipal Building Update**

On October 28, 2025, City Council approved a final Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with FCI Constructors for construction of the new Police and Municipal Building at 311 10th Street. The approved construction cost of \$49,696,966 is actually \$165,444 less than the initial Guaranteed Maximum Price approved by City Council in July 2025. This is further evidence of the project team efforts to work diligently to maintain cost and budget controls to bring this important project in, at, or under budget.

Significant site work continues at the project. All twenty-one of the geothermal wells have been drilled, and the earth work to prepare for foundation installation is continuing.

# Road and Construction Updates



## Right of Way Impacts

Unless otherwise noted, all impacts will be in effect on weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (holidays excluded). Closures will be specifically noted.

**Construction is continuing as part of Golden's 2025 Street Improvement Program.**

**To keep crews and drivers safe, no parking will be allowed in active work zones from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** The City may tow any vehicles parked in these areas during work hours to a nearby location outside the work zone.

During paving, vehicle access will be limited, and drivers should plan to use alternate routes when possible. Traffic will be directed around work areas by flaggers, and streets will reopen as soon as repairs are complete.

Residents should expect construction equipment, traffic, and noise while work is in progress. The contractor will deliver door-hanger notices 48 hours in advance to homes directly affected and will also post "No Parking" signs at least 48 hours before work begins.

Please note that schedules may change quickly due to weather or equipment issues, so be sure to follow the posted signs for the most current information.

Work will begin soon on the following streets:

- 10th St from Ford to Vasquez
- W. 16th St. from South Golden Road to Utah Street

### **10th St – Ford St. to Archer St (Includes side streets at parking lot at Vanover Park)**

- City of Golden I.T. Department telecom work for the new City Hall at 311 10th St
- 10/20 - 11/14/25
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place

### **JeffCo Government Area – Johnson Rd / W 10th Ave**

- Xcel Energy underground electric installation
- 06/23 - 11/21/25
- Monday - Saturday
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place

**Johnson Rd – W 14th Ave to W 10th Ave**

- City of Golden contractor replacing sidewalk
- 10/06 – 10/31/25
- Monday – Friday
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place


**CITYWIDE**

- Xcel Energy overhead power pole replacements/maintenance – wildfire mitigation
- 01/13 - 12/31/25
- Expect construction-related traffic delays and parking/sidewalk impacts with pedestrian detours in place


