


#### **Mondays with the Mayor**

#### **Xcel Public Safety Power Shutoff Today**

Xcel Energy has notified the community of an imminent planned power outage also referred to as a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) that is expected to impact Golden on Wednesday, Dec. 17, at 10:00 a.m. due to extreme dry conditions combined with weather conditions. Forecasted winds may reach 70–80 mph, with gusts up to 85 mph.

City facilities and services — notably the Golden Community Center and City Hall — will be without power and will be closed to the public tomorrow, Wednesday, December 17. Emergency and other essential services will continue to operate as normal.

If you have an emergency or see smoke or fire, call 911 immediately. For non-emergencies, contact Golden Police Dispatch at 303-384-8045.

Please take the following actions in priority order:

- Avoid unnecessary travel. Extreme winds can create dangerous driving conditions and flying debris. Stay off the roads unless absolutely necessary.
- Check in on neighbors with higher needs. Please reach out to older adults, people with disabilities, and anyone who may need help preparing for high winds or a power outage.
- Prepare for a power outage. Build or review your emergency kit, including flashlights, batteries, medications, water, food, chargers, and important documents.
- Ensure vehicles are ready. Fill your gas tank and make sure vehicles are prepared in case travel becomes necessary.

• Secure trash and recycling carts. Keep carts in and bring them out the morning of pickup to prevent wind-related hazards.

The City of Golden offers a simple and eco-friendly way to dispose of your Christmas treeby giving it a second life as mulch! From December 26 through January 26, you can drop off your tree at our NEW collection site located at The Splash, 3151 Illinois St. The site will be open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

To participate, please ensure your tree meets the following guidelines:

- Remove all ornaments, hardware, strings of lights, and tinsel.
- Only live Christmas trees will be accepted.
- Wreaths, tree branches, trash bags, or other wood materials will not be accepted.

The collected trees will be turned into mulch, which will be available for free pickup at a later date at the public site on 11th St., just west of the Clear Creek History Park.


