Temporary Payment System Outage

Beginning Monday, Feb. 2, at 6:00 p.m. through Feb. 3, the City will experience a temporary outage affecting payments processed through the City's online payment portal. Service is expected to be restored by the morning of Wednesday, February 4.

During this outage, both online and in-person payments for the following services will be unavailable:

- Utility billing
- City-collected taxes
- Municipal Court citations

If you have automatic payments scheduled during this timeframe, no action is needed, but we recommend confirming that your payment processed successfully once service is restored.

Free Radon Test Kits Available

In partnership with Jefferson County Public Health, the City of Golden is giving away 25 radon test kits to Golden residents during the month of January as part of the City's Healthy Housing Initiative. These kits will be available at City Hall (911 10th Street) on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Radon is a naturally occurring invisible, odorless gas that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil, rock, and water. About 50% of homes in Colorado have high radon levels. In Colorado, living in a home with average levels of radon is like having 200 chest x-rays every year. Testing for radon is easy and fixing the problem is relatively inexpensive. 
